Each course has a course number. It is followed by the section number, the name of the course, and the number of semester credits given for the satisfactory completion of the course. (Course descriptions include prerequisites and other requirements to be met.)

Course Numbering

- Undergraduate courses: numbered 0700 -4999.

- Graduate courses: numbered 5000- 5999 and 8000-9999.
