The main objective of this project is the creation of an attractive entrance to Kriebel Hall, which is the administrative and historic center of Perkiomen School. The project included the screening of an enormous chilling plant and other utilities placed across from the entrance. The design creates a safe and attractive experience for visitors, students, faculty as an arrival, waiting, drop-off and pick-up area. Runoff from the surrounding building and surfaces is impounded in an existing island graded and planted with native plants to create a Rain Garden.
