The new 35,000 sq. ft. Academic Building is placed to create a Central Plaza along Seminary Avenue and terraced courtyard, with the existing Kehs Hall, as a transition into lower quad. In addition to all the design of all the site work, our firm assisted in the design of the building to create an observatory terrace on the third floor, positioning of building entrances and the configuration of the internal stairs and windows that responded to the campus views.

The courtyard consists of green parterres where school events, such as graduation, can take place. The design of the courtyard is embellished with retaining walls, steps and a pergola to create a variety of opportunities to “hang out”.
