To The Student

In order to take any of the following courses: Chemistry 283, 284, 293, 294, 297, 298, you must be a junior or senior major in one of the sciences with a cumulative overall GPA of 2.75 or higher. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Research courses require a written report at the end of each semester. You will not receive a grade for the course until such a report is submitted to your faculty research mentor at least one week prior to the last day of classes. You must also turn in your original laboratory notebook and all associated data to your mentor. You are expected to be completely honest in your reporting of data, and to avoid all forms of plagiarism.

To The Research Mentor

The fact that the research report must be submitted to the program director shall not be taken to imply that the director will sit in judgment of the faculty research program. The specific format of the report is left up to the faculty mentor, but it is expected that reports for Chemistry 283, 284, 293, 294 will be more substantial than those for 297 and 298. The research mentor will be responsible for submitting a grade. This form, along with end-of-semester reports, will be submitted to the Program Director and kept on file in the Chemistry Office in Beury Hall Room 201.
