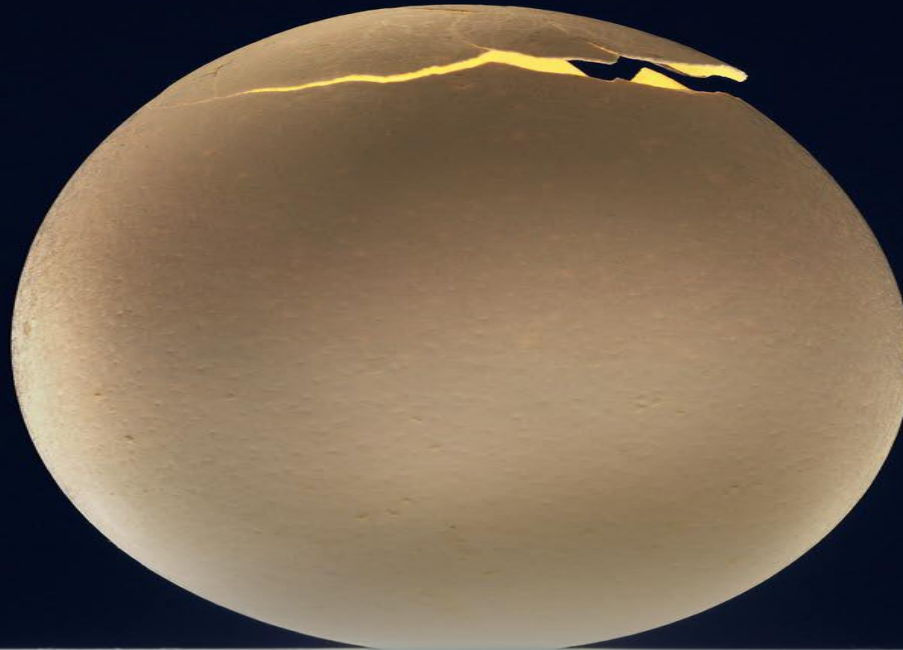

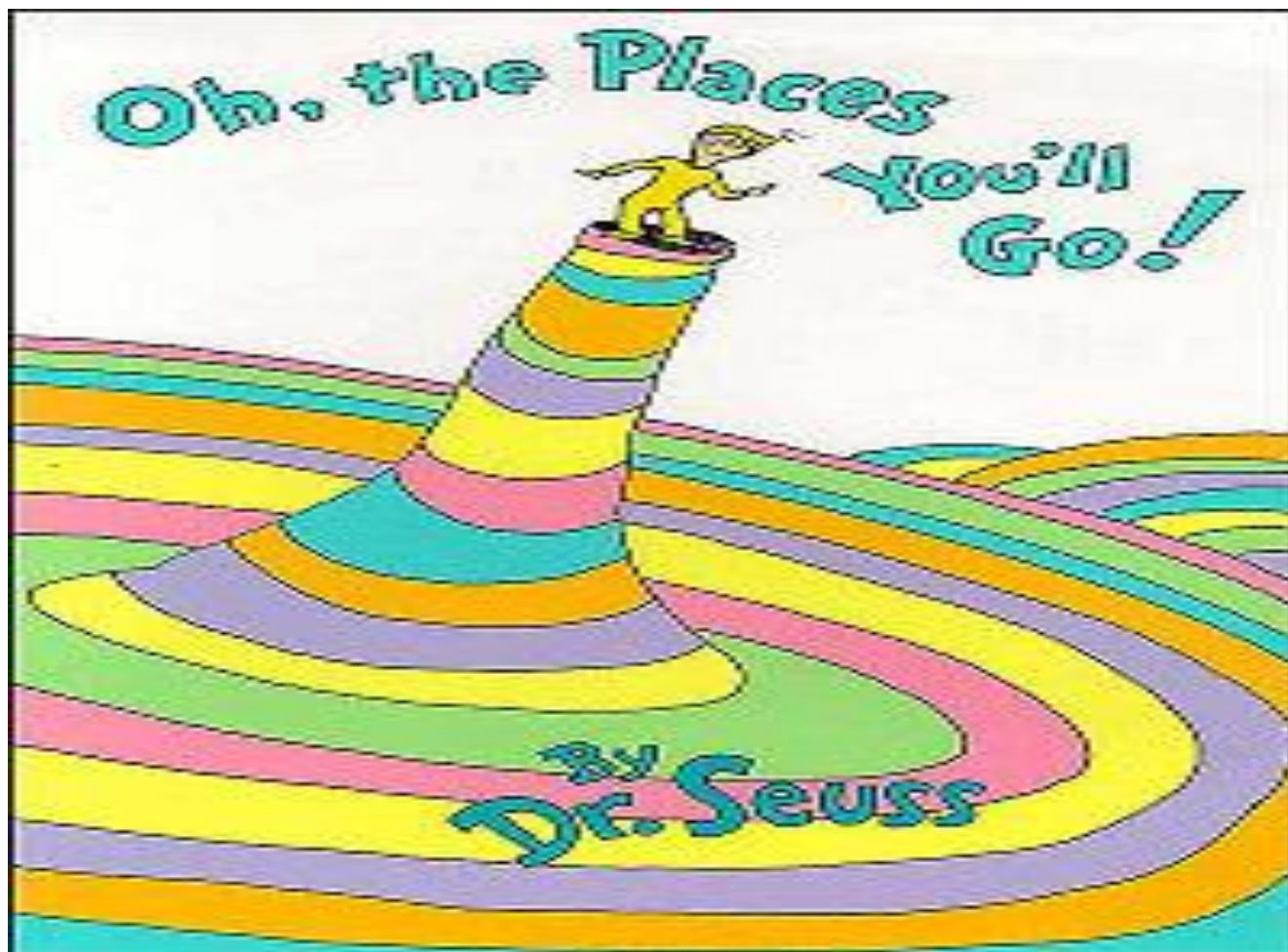

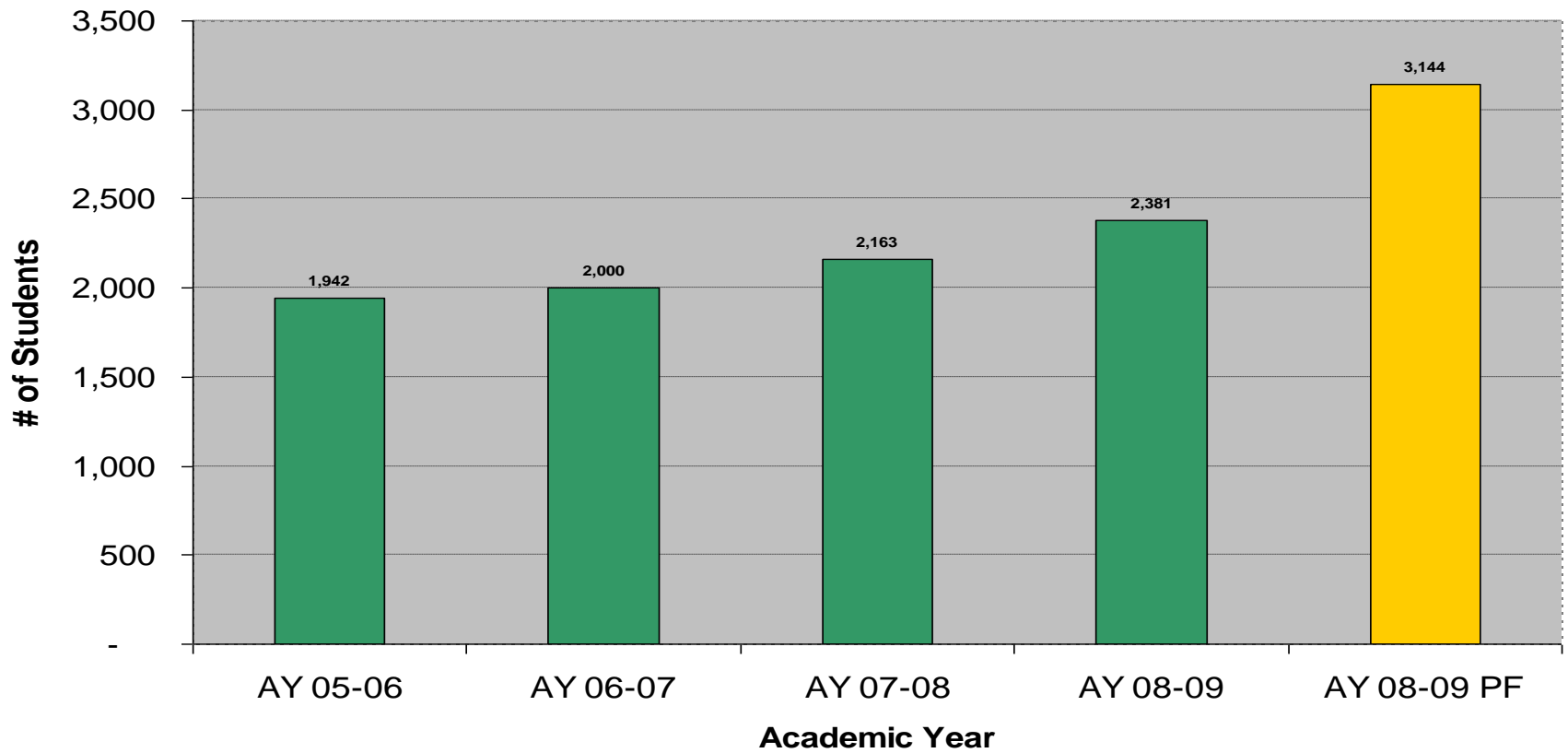


Goals

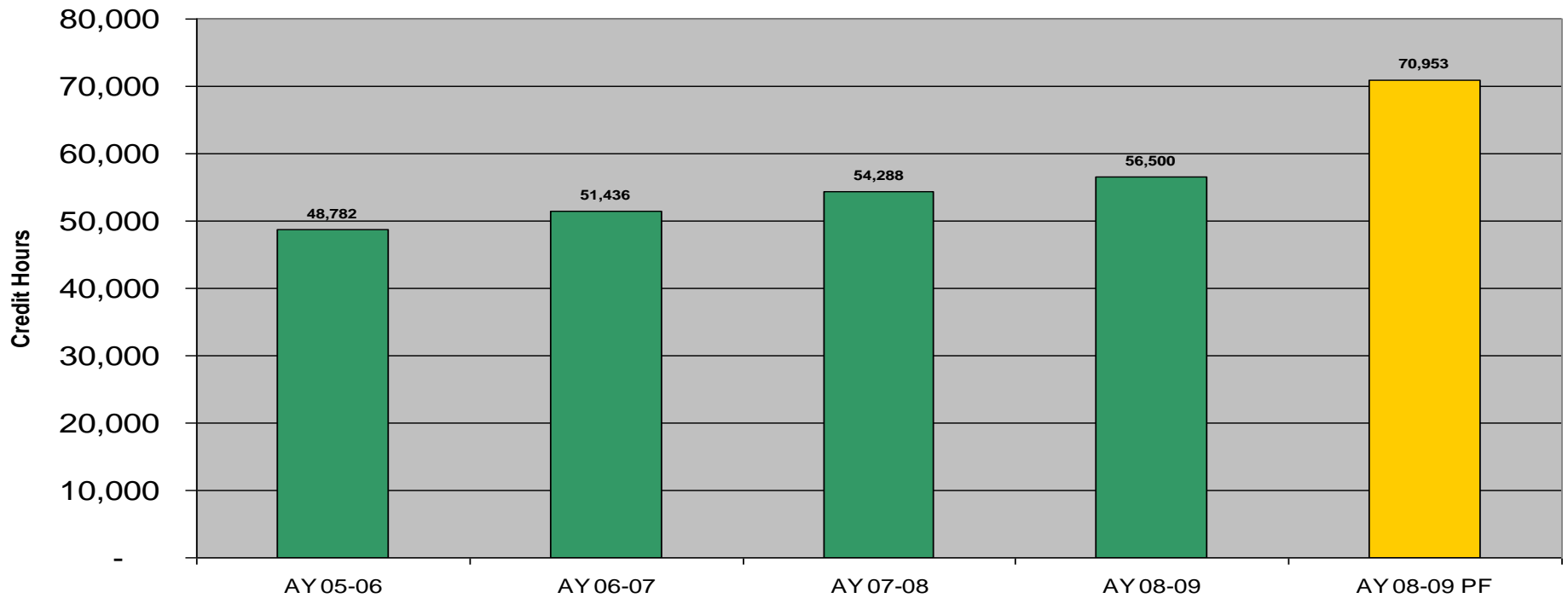
College of Health Professions and Social Work Enrollment





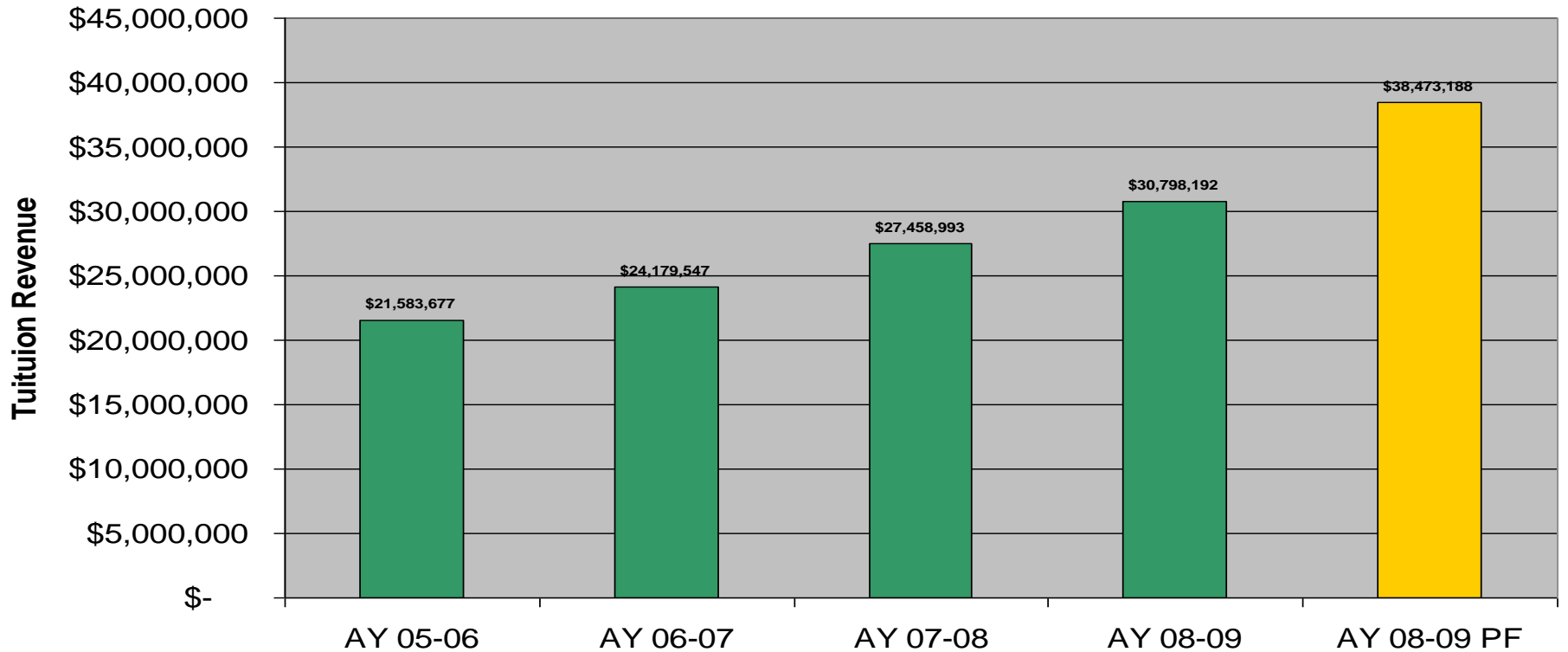
College of Health Professions and Social Work

Credit Hours Generated





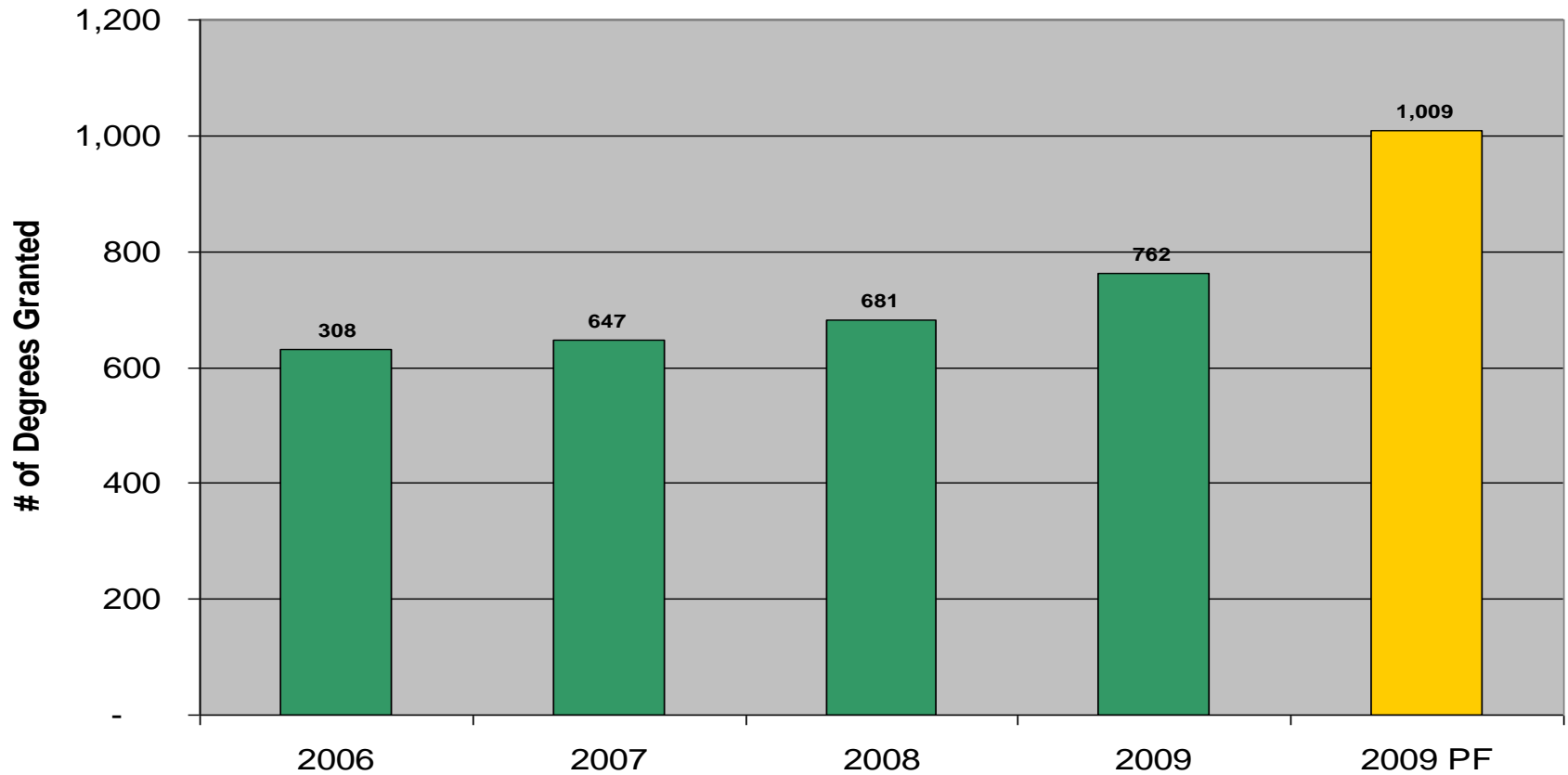
College of Health Professions and Social Work

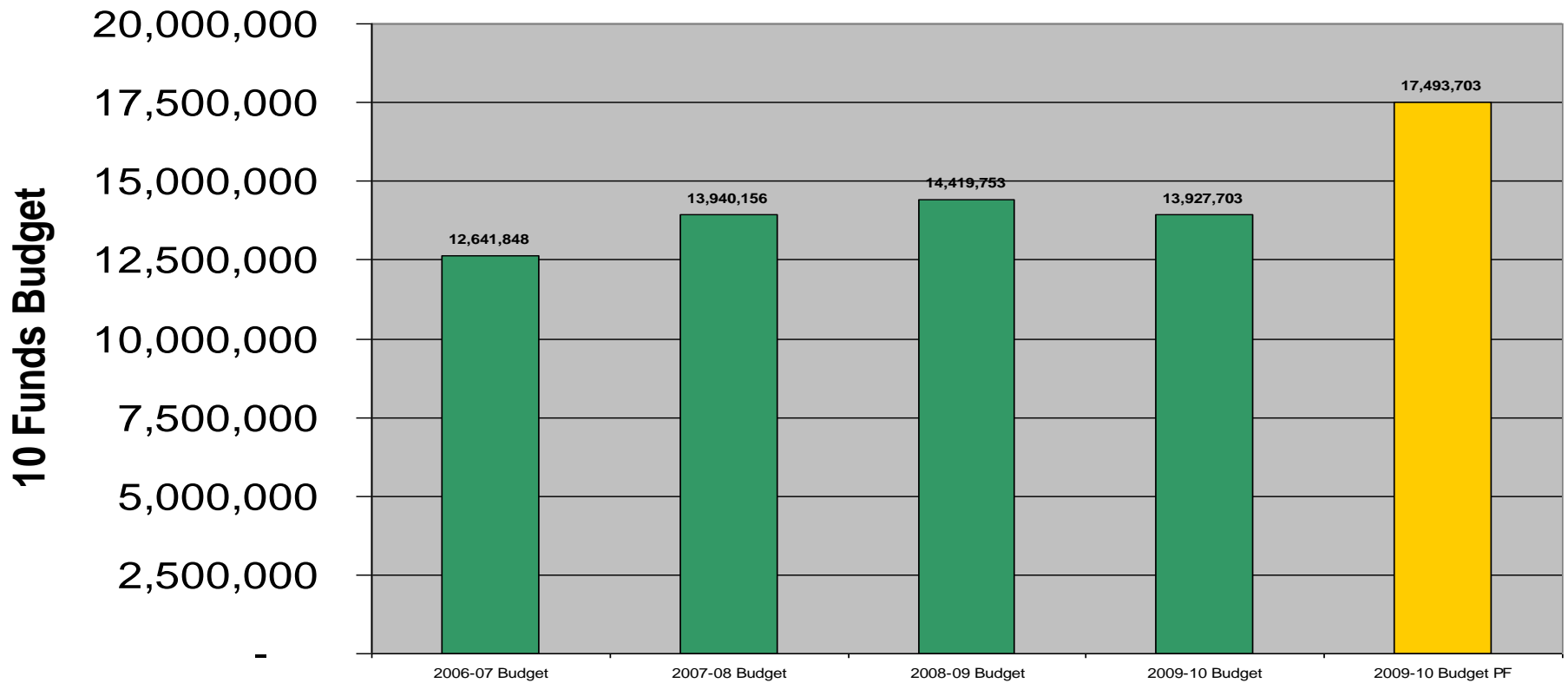
of Degrees Granted





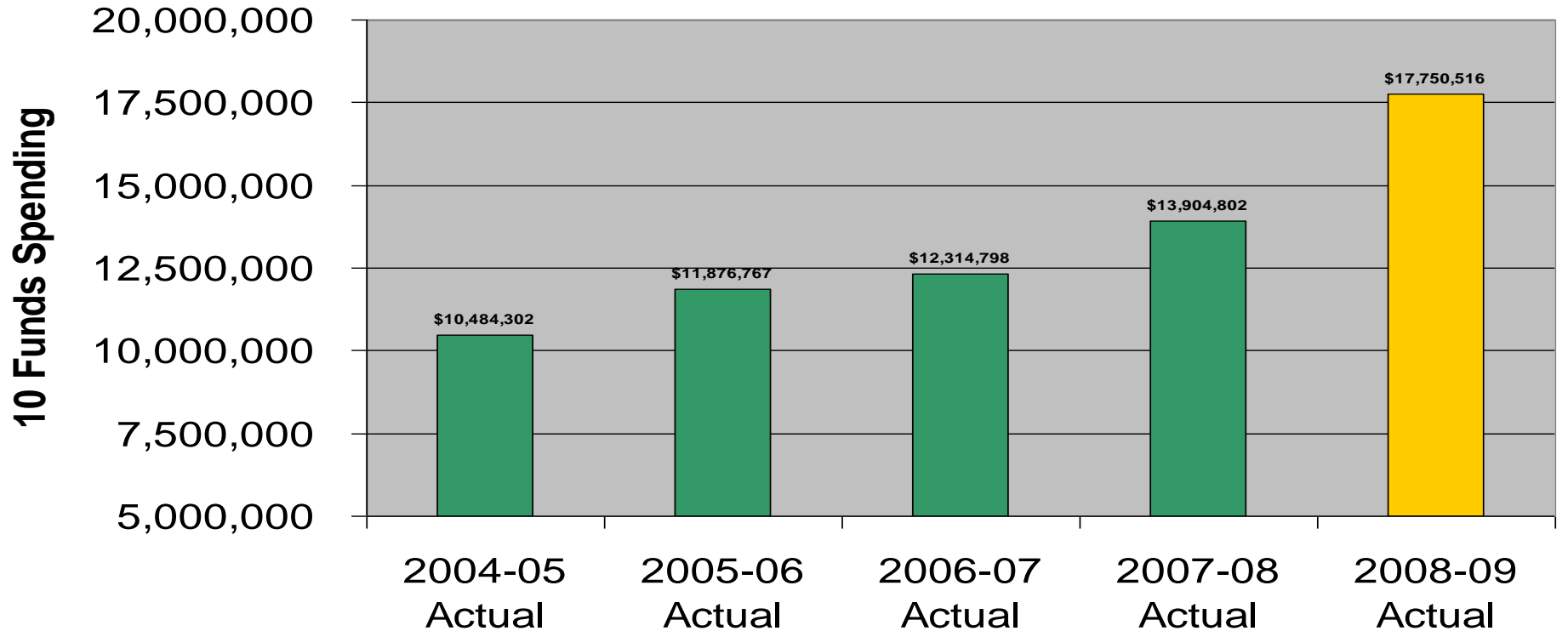

Budget





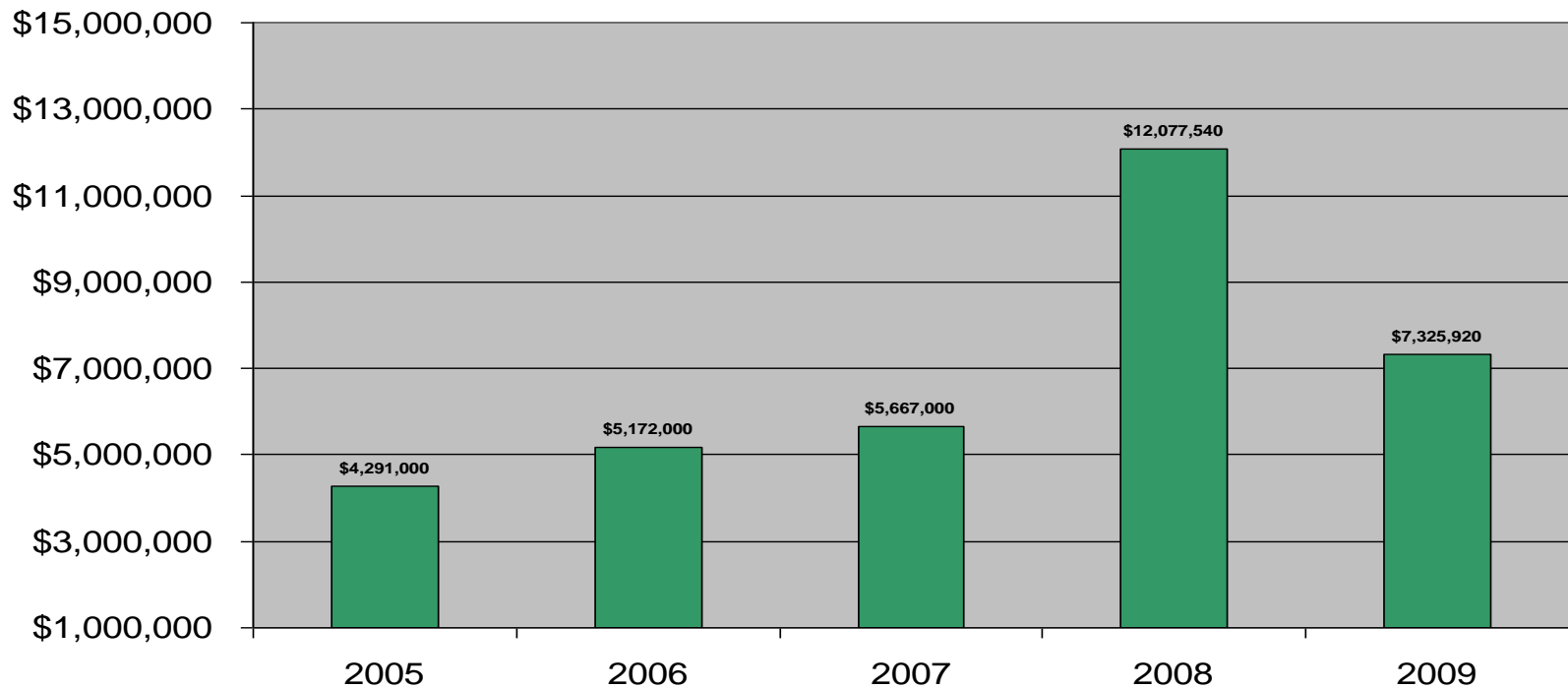

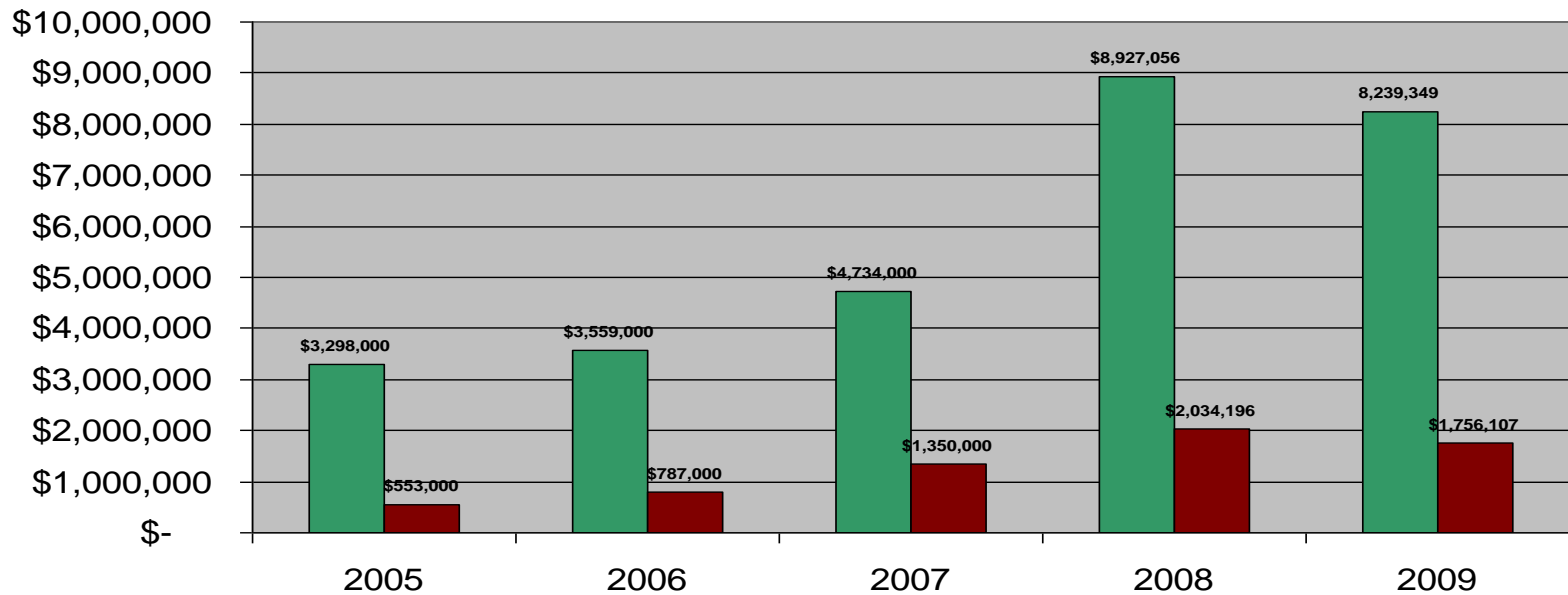
Sponsored Research - New Awards
