Thus, the TURF Planning Council requests that each department first review its nominations internally, and then nominate to TURF the best of these. Departments may nominate individual students and/or panels; however, the TURF Review Committee evaluates each panel paper individually and cannot guarantee that all panel papers will be accepted. Departments may nominate as many individuals or panels as meet the TURF criteria. In addition to meeting the TURF academic criteria, nominated works should, at the time of nomination, reflect a presentation reading length of 10-12 minutes. Nominating faculty must be willing to work with each nominee to help him or her prepare for TURF presentation in the event that the TURF Review Committee accepts the nominee's work for conference presentation. TURF finalists will be notified via email by February 25, 2009.	Please note that all CLA nominations MUST be completed and submitted by faculty; students may NOT nominate themselves.
