GenEd Peer Teachers	Temple GenEd	An undergraduate who has previously taken a GenEd class	<p>A GenEd Peer Teacher is an undergraduate who has previously taken a GenEd class and received at least an A- (or its equivalent). S/he is hired to help you re-think/improve the course and to help students who are currently enrolled succeed.</p> <p>GenEd Peer Teachers receive a \$2,250 for approximately 15 weeks (including a \$300 stipend for the two-day pre-semester Teaching Institute). Peer Teachers are also eligible for tuition remission for the one (1) credit hour Peer Teacher Internship.
