Excellent organizational, management, sales and computer skills are necessary. Members of the Internship Program will be exposed to all facets of a **minor league baseball organization** and will gain practical, in-depth experience from one of the following positions:

Box Office/Ticketing Intern

Assist the Box Office Manager with all ticketing aspects at ballpark. Duties may include but not be limited to sale, maintenance, and fulfillment of all tickets (season, day of game, luxury suite, group) and day-to-day operations of retail ticket office.

Promotions Intern

Coordinate and participate in on-field promotions. Work with Community Relations Department in scheduling and fulfilling player/mascot appearances, pocket schedule distribution and other assigned projects.

Game Operations Intern

Assist fans in many different ways (finding their seats, answering questions etc.) Maintain a clean and organized ballpark. Have the flexibility of working in many different areas at the ballpark. Help get stadium ready prior to the game and have the Opportunity to be "Supervisor of a home stand" this summer

Facility Management Intern

Responsibilities include planning/coordinating game day staff, community use of the facility, ballpark upkeep, management of ushers/ticket takers and parking lot employees, and other duties as assigned.

Merchandise Intern

Help management of the merchandise store, stock shelves, track inventory, and assist in ordering merchandise. Assisting customers answering questions about merchandise.

Media/Public Relations Intern

Assist with all aspects of public, media, and community relations. Duties also include photography, sponsor relations, and press box needs.

Grounds Crew Intern

Maintain grounds and playing field, which includes; mowing, fertilizing, aerating, topdressing and cultivating. Setup field for game time lining the field and working on batters box and pitchers mound on game days.

Food and Beverage Intern

Assist the Director of Food and Beverage with the following responsibilities: ordering, inventory, stocking, event night supervision and management, and vendor relations.

Baseball Operations Intern

Assist the Head of Player Personnel with day-to-day operations including learning all aspects of writing and negotiating player contracts. Also responsible for cleaning and maintaining the home and visitors clubhouse, player laundry and any other player needs.

Finance Intern

Gain hands-on experience and training in many areas including business and operational management, accounting/finance and human resources.

Most internship positions are unpaid but can be used towards college credit and/or experience.
