

# ADDENDUM

## Waivers

### ARTS

(p. 15 Advisors' Handbook, Spring 2008)

For students pursuing undergraduate degrees from Boyer College of Music & Dance or Tyler School of Art, waivers were granted in recognition that the totality of the program constituted significant interaction with the Arts and far exceeded the competencies developed after completing the Gen Ed Arts requirement.

Thus, Boyer College of Music & Dance and Tyler School of Art identified a sequence of four courses that undergraduates complete in the normal course of their studies that when completed will signify the fulfillment of the Arts requirement.

For Dance majors:

Dance 1811, Dance 2813, Dance 2814, and Dance 3815

For Music majors;

Music Studies 1711, Music Studies 1712, Music Studies 2711, and Music Studies 2712

For Tyler majors;

Art 1101, Art 1201, Art 1401 (Art 1496 or Art 1996) and Art 1501

The student must complete all four courses listed to successfully complete the Arts requirement. If a student changes majors before completing all four courses in the identified sequence, s/he must complete a Gen Ed Arts course to satisfy the requirement.

## Transfer Issues

### SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY REQUIREMENTS

(p. 14 Advisors' Handbook Spring 2008)

Beginning in 2010 transfer students may fulfill Gen Ed Science & Technology courses in several ways and largely depends on how many credits the student has completed and the total credit hours in Science & Technology that the student transfers.

Students who transfer to Temple with 45 or more credits and have not transferred any Science courses will be required to complete one Gen Ed Science and Technology (GS) course at Temple.

Students who transfer to Temple with fewer than 45 credits and have completed one Science course in transfer, will be required to complete one Gen Ed Science and Technology (GS) course at Temple. If the Science course the student previously completed is one of the courses listed in the approved two course sequences, the student can also fulfill the requirement by completing the sequence.

Students who transfer to Temple with fewer than 45 credits and have completed two Science courses in transfer will have completed their Gen Ed Science and Technology requirement.

Students with fewer than 45 credits and who have not completed any transferable Science & Technology courses may satisfy the requirement by successfully completing any two Gen Ed Science & Technology courses; by completing an approved two-sequence course series as designated in the waiver policy; or by completing the first course in an approved two-sequence course as designated in the waiver policy and one Gen Ed Science & Technology course.
