**Green Cities - Clean Waters:  
A sustainable approach to water utility management**

The City of Philadelphia's move towards green infrastructure and sustainability practices are strongly supported by the Philadelphia Water Department's Office of Watersheds (OOW). The OOW, created in 2000, combined the Department's separate programs for Combined Sewer Overflow, Stormwater Management, and Source Water Protection. Today, these programs have been fully integrated into a **Green Cities - Clean Waters Program** which uses land, waterway, infrastructure and sustainability practices in support of policies and programs for the protection of drinking water supply, the propagation and protection of fish and wildlife habitat, and in support of the region's green development practices, recreation, ecotourism and sustainable riverfront re-development efforts.
