- 2. Departmental Letter of Support
- 3. Letters of Recommendation (2-3)
- 4. Applicant's Statement of Interests and Goals

- 5. Undergraduate and Graduate Transcripts\*\*
- 6. Standardized Test Scores
- 7. Proof of Admission as Posted by the Graduate School on the Applicant's Electronic Student Record

Each of the items listed above is given considerable weight by the members of the Graduate Board's Fellowship Committee, which determines the fellowship awards. If any information is missing, the nomination will not be considered.

- Nominees who are not awarded the Presidential Fellowship will be automatically considered for University and Future Faculty Fellowships, which carry lesser stipends.
- \*\* All international students must submit transcripts that have been evaluated for equivalency by a recognized credential service, such as World Education Services (WES) or Educational Credential Evaluators (ECE), or by the foreign credential evaluator in the Graduate School.
