Dr. Brian McDonough is Clinical Professor of Family Medicine at Temple University School of Medicine and Chairman of the Department of Family Medicine at St. Francis Hospital. In his role as Chairman, Department of Family Medicine, he oversees the Family Medicine Residency Program, The St. Clare Medical Outreach Van, The Center of Hope, Tiny Steps and various satellite offices including Sacred Heart. In 2009 he was named to serve as a member of the St. Francis Hospital Board of Directors. From 1993-2008, he served as Associate Director of The St. Francis Family Medicine Program.

Dr. Brian McDonough is also well known for his work in television and radio conveying medical information. His medical features are syndicated on more than 500 media outlets throughout the United States. Dr. McDonough got his broadcasting start at KYW Newsradio in Philadelphia and since 1988 he has been that city's medical voice. He is the recipient of four Emmy Awards which he earned over a twenty-year career with Fox television. Dr. McDonough serves as Senior Medical Editor for www.mymedicalreports.com. He has been a regular contributor to NBC's Today Show and is Medical Editor for several health publication companies. He is on The Medical Advisory Board for Omnia Education, Inc. and in that capacity helps in the process of continuing medical education for physicians and nurses nationwide. Dr. McDonough is a strong believer that the medical information that he provides be used as a resource to aid in the path to good health, but he insists that all ideas and questions be discussed with a personal physician before putting them into place.

Dr. Brian McDonough received his MD degree from Temple University and later completed a Fellowship in Faculty Development. He has won numerous awards including The American Cancer Sword of Hope Award, The American Academy of Pediatrics Annual Award, and The Sir William Osler Award for Bedside Teaching. In 2006, he was named Family Physician of The Year by The Delaware Academy of Family Physicians. Dr. McDonough was honored as 2006 DAFP Family Physician of the Year and is a Sir William Osler Award winner for his role in medical student and resident education at both Temple and St. Francis. He has been honored by The American Medical Association, The American Cancer Society, and The American Heart Association for his work as a physician. Dr. McDonough maintains an active practice and is a Fellow of The American Academy of Family Physicians and The College of Physicians of Philadelphia, and Chairman of The PhillyHealthInfo Advisory Board.
