Stephen R. Permut, M.D.,J.D. is Professor and Chair of the Department of Family and Community Medicine at Temple University School of Medicine and is also the Associate Dean for Academic Affiliations.

Dr. Permut is a graduate of the College of Arts and Sciences at the University of Pennsylvania and the Temple University School of Medicine. He did his postgraduate training in internal medicine at the Indiana University Medical Center in Indianapolis. He then started a solo, private practice in general medicine in the inner city of Wilmington, Delaware. Subsequently, he attended Law School at Widener University. Dr. Permut is board certified in Internal Medicine, Family Medicine, and Legal Medicine.
