

**Michael Campbell** joined the faculty of the Villanova University School of Law as a Reuschlein Clinical Teaching Fellow in 2008, following thirty years as a public interest attorney and advocate for the poor. From 1978 to 1993, he was as an elder law specialist with the Delaware County Legal Assistance Association. In 1993, he co-founded the Pennsylvania Health Law Project, where he served first as Managing Attorney and then as Executive Director. For two decades he was counsel to the Consumer Subcommittee of Pennsylvania's Medical Assistance Advisory Committee. In 1999 he was awarded the Pennsylvania Legal Services Excellence Award.
