Official Temple holidays are:

Thanksgiving Day: Thursday 11/24
 Day after Thanksgiving: Friday 11/25
 Christmas Eve: (observed) Friday 12/23

Official Moss holidays are:

Thanksgiving Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day, July 4 Day

Abington: (same as Moss holidays)

** You are expected to report on all regular work days for the facility at which you are rotating. If you have to work on a day that is considered a holiday by Temple, but not recognized as a holiday by your facility (Moss/Abington/DelCo), i.e. Nov 25, then you'll be granted a comp day.
