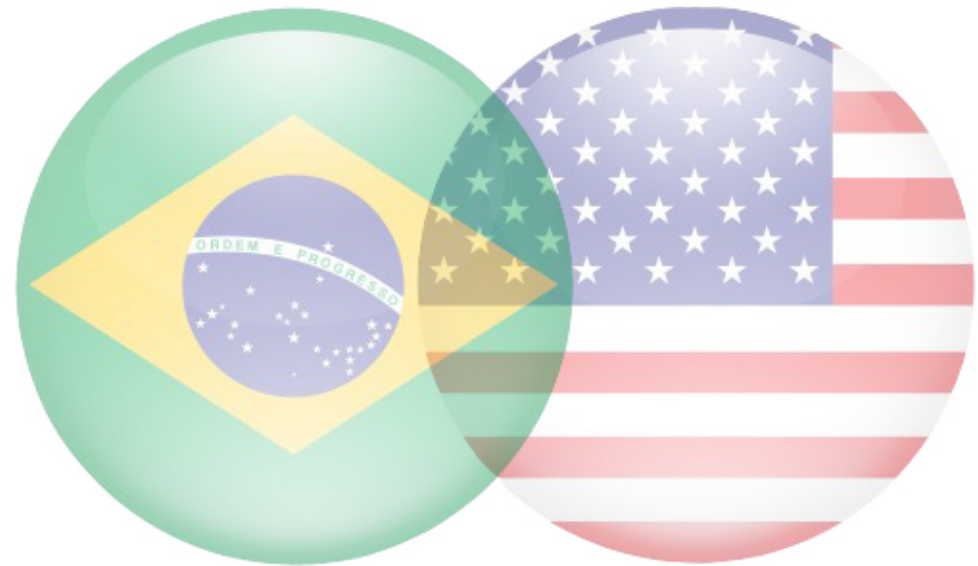

The goal of this project is to promote cross-national awareness and understanding of the significant contributions people with disabilities make to work environments. Program participants will take classes and engage in multi-cultural activities to learn about social considerations and technological solutions that raise employment opportunities for people with disabilities.

Experience

Students will be attending one of two prestigious Brazilian universities while living in either Salvador, Bahia or Curitiba, Parana. In between classes student will have the opportunity to explore the city, to learn and experience the unique culture of Brazil and the individual cities.

Live

After their semester abroad, students will have increased their knowledge of the accommodations for disabilities needed in the workforce and will be able to promote and increase the inclusion of people with disabilities in their workplaces and local communities. In addition, they will have gained invaluable experiences by living and learning in another culture and another language

Calendar/Timeline

The length of the exchange is one semester, in either the Fall or the Spring. Details about paperwork, pre-departure preparations, and the arrival/departure schedule will be provided to candidates.

Courses

Students will take 12-16 credits during their semester abroad. The curriculum will focus on the inclusion and contributions of people with disabilities in the workplace.

Language

Participants will be required to learn basic Portuguese and will be issued an exam prior to departure. The Office of Distance Learning and Summer Programs will provide Portuguese training the semester before departure.

Grant Funding

Participants will receive up to \$3,500 for airfare and housing expenses, sponsored by a grant awarded to Temple's Distance Learning Program from the U.S. Department of Education, the Funds for the Improvement of Post Secondary Education (FIPSE). Students are responsible for the regular Temple tuition rates and their personal expenses.
