

STUDENTS WITH A DISABILITY

The Department of Disability Resources and Services provides support to students with medical, visual, hearing, physical, learning and psychological disabilities.

If you are a student with a disability and require reasonable accommodations during orientation and placement testing, then follow the 5 easy steps below to make these arrangements.

1. Fax/mail your documentation of disability to DRS, along with your contact information, at least four weeks before your placement test date. Documentation guidelines can be viewed at:

2. Call DRS to schedule an appointment (telephone number 215-204-1280)
3. DRS staff will determine placement test accommodations
4. DRS will issue a letter of accommodation to the Measurement and Research Center (MARC)—*MARC manages the placement testing at Temple University*
5. You will call MARC at 215-204-8611 to arrange an appointment to complete your placement test with accommodations.
