



All Temple University Parkers:

On July 5, 2005, it is expected that all Temple University computer systems will begin using the new TUID number. This means that all employees and students must begin using their new OWLcard on that day. The Office of Parking Services is working in conjunction with the University in order to bring about a smooth transition with the new OWLcards, from the previously used Temple University ID cards. With this new OWLcard in place, your Social Security number will no longer be part of your new ID and is no longer required for parking purposes.

In order to aid this conversion, the Office of Parking Services will be allowing all parkers, who were unable to obtain their new OWLcard prior to July 5<sup>th</sup>, to use the old ID for one admittance, until they are able to obtain their new OWLcard. This means that, as of July 5<sup>th</sup>, the old ID will no longer be usable within the Parking Services computer system, although the Parking Attendant will record your name, in order to allow you to park.

This one-time exception is meant to assist in the changeover, and is a courtesy to our parking customers. Please recognize that this exception will be granted only once. Parkers are expected to secure their new ID cards in order to avoid any inconvenience at the parking gates.
