#### **Program Mission:**

The overall purpose of our offender program is to decrease the number of victims and the likelihood of future illegal sexual behaviors, by providing a highly structured, therapeutic environment for juvenile male offenders between the age of 13 and 21, while they remain in the community or when they return to the community but require transitional and/or continued residential services.

#### **Program Objectives**

##### **Primary**
