Licensure Status

Temple University's Clinical Psychology program has graduated 73 Ph.D.'s during the period 1997 – 2005. Of these 73 Clinical Ph.D.'s, 63 (86.3%) are currently licensed, 6 (8.2%) are in the process of applying for and obtaining licensure, 2 (2.7%) are not licensed, 1 (1.4%) is deceased, and 1 (1.4%) could not be located. The 6 students who are in the process of obtaining licensure are more recent graduates. The 2 students who are not licensed (and not in the process of obtaining licensure) do not require licensure for their current positions and career paths; thus, they do not intend to become licensed.

Full time student status requires that students be enrolled for at least 6 hours per semester under most circumstances.

Students in their first two years are often enrolled for 12 hours per semester, less in most later semesters.

Tuition costs for students in their first four years are typically waived in their entirety.

Students on internship (most typically in their fifth year) need to be registered for at least one hour of internship credit each academic year semester, and these expenses fall to the student, as do any other tuition expenses or fees accrued after the first four years of graduate study, which includes at least one hour of dissertation research credit in the semester of the final dissertation orals.
