Details and Requirements for Scholarship:

Undergraduate students with at least a 3.0 GPA, a declared major within the School of Communications and Theater and demonstrated financial need may apply for a scholarship in one of the three following areas:

1. Internships - must be taken for credit and take place in a subsequent semester
2. International Study Programs - must be for credit and a Temple program
3. Independent Projects – must have a faculty mentor
4. If applicable, scholarships may be subject to the student being granted admission into a program.

This scholarship can be awarded in conjunction with other school scholarships. If awarded the scholarship, student will be required to write a thank you note to Mr. Klein (instructions to be provided).

Applicants must also submit:

1. One page typewritten essay that incorporates the following information:

- a. Describe your internship/independent project/international study program and articulate how it will help you achieve your educational and professional goals.
- b. Describe how this experience/project will complement your education and/or help you reach your long-term objectives.
- c. Include any other information you would like the committee to know about you.

2. Typewritten resume which details the following:

- a. Extracurricular or volunteer activities at Temple University or in the community.
 - b. Internships and/or paid employment experiences.
 - c. Honors, awards or scholarships.
 - d. Publications, exhibitions and performances.
- c. Honors, awards, or scholarships.

3. Two recommendation letters from faculty members and/or employers (more may be submitted if desired).
