Eligibility Requirements:

- ✓ All students who wish to borrow FFELP funds must have a completed 2009-10 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with Temple University.
- ✓ Non-matriculated students who are enrolled in courses required by the State of Pennsylvania for elementary or secondary teacher certification or recertification are eligible for Stafford Loan funding and are required to be enrolled at least half time.
- ✓ *Optional courses or certification programs that are not required by the state for elementary or secondary teacher certification that a student elects to take for professional recognition or advancement do not qualify.*
- ✓ New loan borrowers must complete an Entrance Interview by going online to the SFS website at www.temple.edu/sfs and clicking the Entrance Interview link in the tool bar on the left side of the page.
- ✓ A full time student may borrow a maximum of \$5,500 in subsidized funding with up to \$7,000 unsubsidized funding per year.
