Enrollment and resources must be considered when determining your eligibility for Summer Financial Aid. Complete this form and return it to the Student Financial Services Office at the school or campus you are or will be attending as soon as possible so we can process your request.

At Temple University, the academic year begins with the fall semester and ends with the summer session(s). Financial aid eligibility is based on application information provided during the fall 2010 and spring 2011 academic year. In order to be considered for summer 2011 financial aid students must meet federal and university aid eligibility requirements, listed on the Student Financial Services website www.temple.edu/sfs.

Keep in mind that your eligibility for all types of summer student aid (i.e. Federal Stafford Loan) will be limited if you have already used your eligibility during the fall 2010 and spring 2011 semesters therefore, you may not be eligible for additional funds from that aid program during the Summer 2011 session(s). Federal Stafford Loan eligibility and annual loan limit information is available on the reverse side of this form.

If you have not exhausted your Stafford Loan eligibility for 2010-2011, we will certify your remaining maximum eligibility up to cost of attendance. If you do not have remaining eligibility for Stafford Loan, you may wish to consider borrowing a GRAD PLUS Loan. To find out you remaining eligibility for summer 2011 Stafford loans, or for Grad PLUS Loan eligibility, please contact Student Financial Services.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Eligibility for Summer 2011 assistance of any kind requires that you file a 2010-2011 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) before the federal deadline of June 30, 2011. File your application on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
2. First time Federal Stafford Loan borrowers are required to complete an Entrance Interview online at <http://www.temple.edu/sfs>.
3. Students must also meet academic progress requirements. A copy of the Academic Progress Standards for graduate students is available on our website www.temple.edu/sfs.

Enrollment Requirement:

1. Graduate students must be enrolled at least half time (minimum 4.5 credit hours) to be considered for federal loan funding. Dissertation students please see your graduate department.
2. For Federal Work-Study you must be enrolled at least half time (minimum 4.5 credit hours) and/or pre-registered at least half-time for fall 2011 (4.5 credits). NOTE: If you are **NOT** attending summer school you must have both a 2010-2011 and a 2011-2012 FAFSA on file to establish eligibility.
3. If you change your enrollment it may affect the amount of the Federal Stafford Loan or GRAD PLUS Loan you receive or your eligibility to participate in the Federal Work-Study Program.

Important Notice

Student's participating in the summer 2011 Federal Work Study program can begin working on **May 16, 2011**. Summer 2011 Federal Work Study payroll will end on **August 14, 2011**.

Regulations governing Federal Work Study (FWS) require a portion of summer earnings be used to meet educational expenses during the following academic year if you do not attend summer classes at least half-time. These attributed earnings (as called by regulation) are considered a resource offsetting calculated need.

The amount is determined using the formula:

$$\begin{array}{r}
 \text{Gross summer earnings} \\
 - \text{ taxes} \\
 - \text{ job related expenses} \\
 \hline
 = \text{Attributable earnings}
 \end{array}$$

Example: a graduate commuter student with gross summer FWS earnings of \$2,300.00 is expected to contribute \$1,274.00 from these earnings toward 2011-2012 educational expenses. The computation of attributed earnings for this student is as follows:

Federal Stafford Loans will be available if you are an eligible student and have not received the maximum amount of Federal Stafford Loan eligibility during the previous fall and spring semesters.
