- Main Campus returning residents

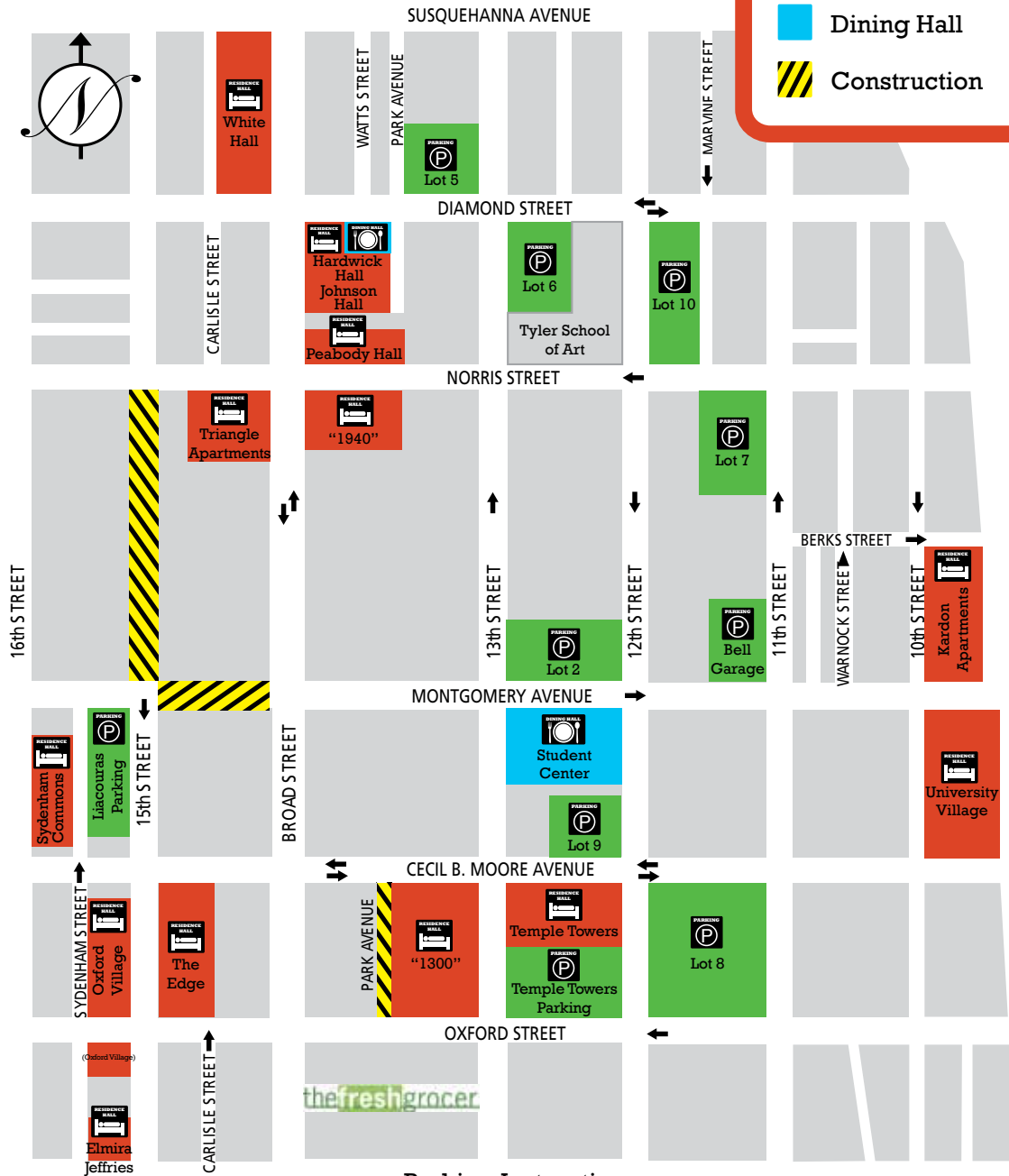


Move-In Parking

Temple Towers and "1300" use **Lot 8, Lot 9, and Temple Towers Parking** (if full use the Liacouras Parking Garage)

Peabody and "1940" use **Lot 7 and Lot 10** (if full use the Liacouras Parking Garage)

Johnson and Hardwick and White Hall use **Lot 5, Lot 6, and Lot 10** (if full use the Liacouras Parking Garage)

The Edge Apartment Complex use **Liacouras Parking Garage**.

Charges will be assessed for Valet Parking.

8:00 am - 11:00 am	Floors 2, 4, & 6	Floors 3, 5, & 7
11:00 am - 2:00 pm	Floors 8 & 10	Floors 9 & 11

All students checking into Johnson or Hardwick Hall should report first to the check-in location directly outside of the Johnson or Hardwick complex to receive their room keys and other check-in material.

Once a student has checked in, he/she can check out a cart with his/her Temple University ID.

In the event of inclement weather, students checking into Johnson Hall or Hardwick Hall should proceed to the lower level of the building.

Once students have received their keys, they should enter the buildings through the main entrance. Johnson Hall Residents should enter the building and go right, Hardwick residents should enter the building and go left. There are two elevators in each building that will be operated by staff to ensure that they are operating efficiently. There will also be staff and volunteers on hand to assist and direct new students or answer any questions students or parents may have.

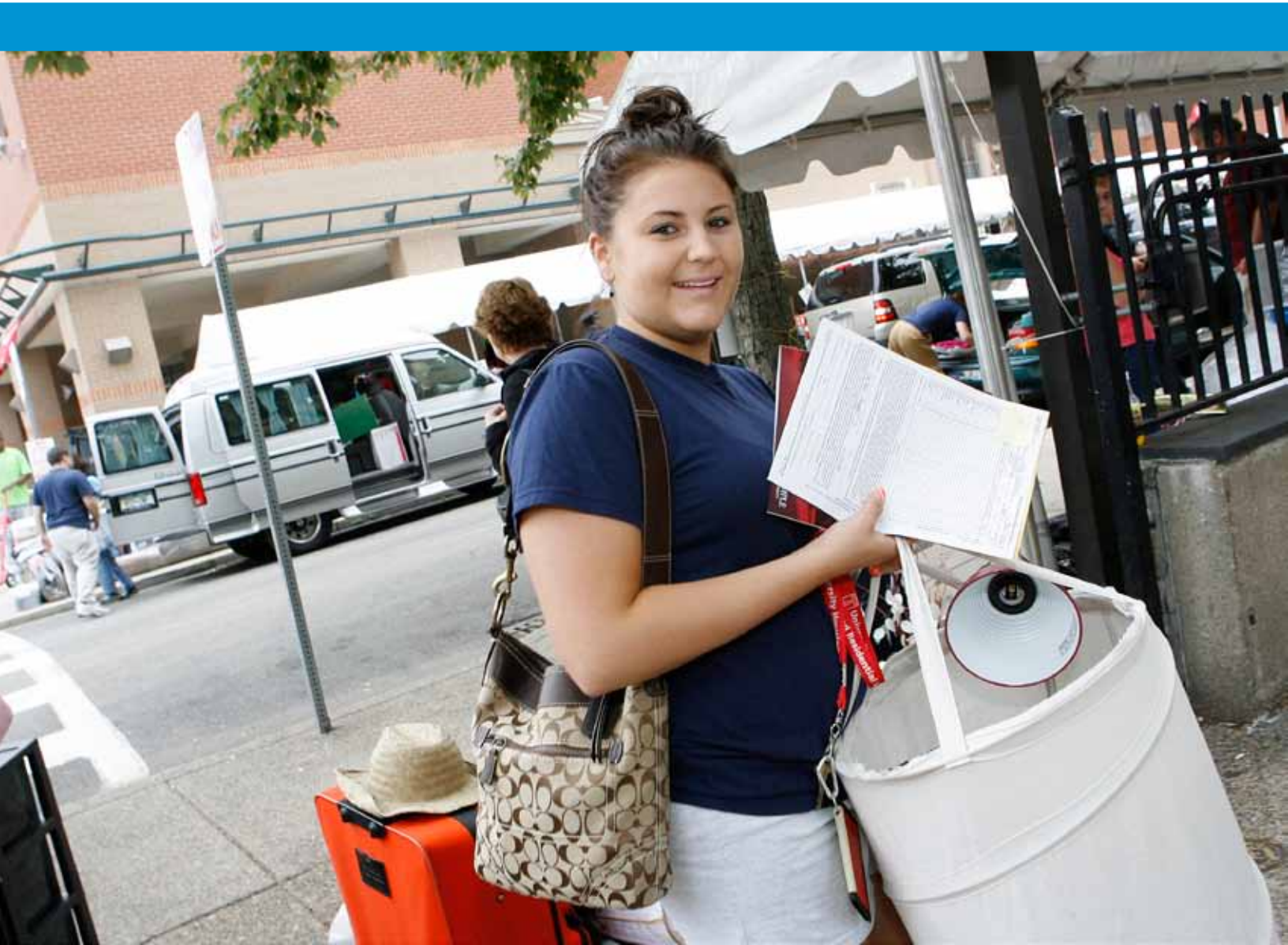

Students checking into Peabody Hall should temporarily park in the “30 minute area” parking behind Peabody Hall and along Norris Street. There are a limited number of parking spaces, so we ask that you move your automobile promptly after you have unloaded your belongings to the curb. The time limit during move-in is 15 minutes.

Peabody Hall check-in is through the main entrance in the basement. Once a student has checked in, he/she can check out a cart with his/her University ID at the front desk. There is one elevator in this four-story building. Most people find it easier and more convenient to use one of the stairways to move in. Note: This elevator is used during Move-In and during the academic year for residents/guest with mobility issues.

Students checking into “1940” should enter the gates under the building to check-in. Students checking into “1940” should temporarily park in the “30 minute area” behind Peabody and along Norris Street. The time limit during move-in is 15 minutes. Once a student has checked in, he/she can check out a cart with his/her University ID in front of the building. There are two elevators in the building that will be operated by staff members.

Once a student has checked in, he/she can check out a cart with his/her University ID at the entrance of White Hall. There are two elevators in the building that will be operated by staff members.

Students should first report to the check-in area in front of “1300”. As the student checks in, he/she will be directed to park their vehicle in a specific unloading area designated for his/her building and wing. Students will be able to check out a cart with their University ID. There are four elevators in the central core of the complex leading to both the North and South buildings. The elevators will be operated by staff members.

Depending on available space, cars may temporarily park in front of Temple Towers on Cecil B. Moore Avenue to unload. The time limit is 15 minutes. Students will check-in at the Courtyard/Pool area in the back of the building. Once a student has checked in, he/she can check out a cart with their University ID. Temple Towers is equipped with four elevators, two elevators on the East Tower and two on the West Tower.
