## History

1977 Alpha Delta Mu National Social Work Honor Society was founded in the fall of 1976 by the late Dr. J. Lawrence Feagins at Morgan State University. In 1977, Alpha Delta Mu was incorporated under the non-profit laws of the State of Maryland and became a national organization as chapters were established in many colleges and universities throughout the United States. The Temple University was established on June 23, 1981.

# Criteria for Membership

Membership Fee: \$25.00

## Undergraduate Student Requirements:

- ◆ A student must be a social work or social welfare major in a program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.
- ◆ Must be junior or senior year status as determined by the School of Social Administration
- ◆ Must have a cumulative GPA of at a 3.5 or above.
- ◆ Must have completed or currently enrolled in SW 3005 with a total of 28 credits completed at Temple University

## Transfer Undergraduate Student Requirements:

- ◆ Complete all of the general requirements except admittance is based on completion of 12 credits at Temple University

## Graduate Student Requirements

- ◆ Graduate Applicants must be in their advance year of study
- ◆ Must have completed at least 12 credits at Temple University
- ◆ Must have maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or above.
