

Applying to a Temple University Summer Abroad Program

Eligibility

Eligibility for all summer programs is limited to those students who:

- possess a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale from all colleges/universities attended.
- are enrolled as full-time matriculated students at the time of application.
- intend a full-time program of study while abroad and will be applying credits earned toward a degree.
- are not on academic and/or disciplinary probation or warning.

Note: Certain programs have additional eligibility requirements; please refer to the individual program descriptions online.

Students will be selected mainly on the basis of their intellectual purpose and emotional maturity. Successful candidates are usually notified within two weeks of receiving a completed application.

Scholarships

Qualified matriculated Temple students wishing to enroll as full-time students (9-13 credits) in the Tokyo Summer Session at Temple University, Japan Campus (TUJ), may apply for scholarships of up to \$4,000 for the summer. These scholarships have been designated to enable more Temple students to study at TUJ in order to expand U.S.-Japan educational exchange. Scholarship eligibility: Applicant must be a full-time, matriculated undergraduate at Temple University; be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident; and have completed the equivalent of four undergraduate semesters with a cumulative GPA of 3.0. Selected finalists will be interviewed.

For all other summer programs, a limited number of \$500 scholarships are available to qualified Temple students. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit and financial need. Scholarship eligibility: Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time, matriculated student at Temple University at the time of application for a scholarship; have a 3.0 cumulative grade point average; enroll as a full-time student while abroad; demonstrate financial need; and be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.

Temple students who meet the eligibility requirements will be considered for a scholarship if they indicate interest on the program application and submit the additional essay to International Programs by February 15.

Application Requirements and Procedures

The application deadline for all of the summer programs is February 15. Early application is encouraged; applications are considered on a rolling-admissions basis. Applications received after the deadline are considered on a space-available basis and must be accompanied by the non-refundable \$200 program deposit, which will be refunded only if the applicant is not accepted into the program.

In addition to completing the application form, students are required to submit the following:

- An academic recommendation, on the recommendation form supplied, from a faculty member who has recently taught you.
- Non-Temple students must submit official transcript(s) for all university/college-level work completed to date. Notes: While we do accept summer program applications during the fall semester, acceptance to a program is provisional until grades from the fall semester are posted to the transcript and reviewed. Non-Temple students must submit an updated official transcript, with fall semester grades, to complete the review process. Temple students are not required to submit transcripts. If necessary information is missing from your academic file, International Programs will contact you to request this information. This may include obtaining an official transcript.
- Non-Temple students must also submit the home college approval form and a non-refundable application fee of \$50.

Please refer to online program descriptions for any program-specific application requirements.

Certain programs require that candidates are interviewed; telephone interviews are conducted for those who cannot be interviewed personally.

Transcripts, recommendations and the home college approval form must be received by the deadline but may be sent under separate cover. **Applications are not reviewed until all supporting documents have been received.**
