

**TEMPLE UNIVERSITY – IFSA/BUTLER UNIVERSITY**  
**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: SCHOLARSHIPS**

International Programs is very pleased to announce that qualified Temple University students may apply for financial assistance for a semester studying on a program sponsored by the Institute for Study Abroad at Butler University. Five scholarships of \$1,000 will be provided by IFSA-Butler for the fall or spring semesters. For all scholarship recipients, scholarships are credited toward the students' Butler bill.

IFSA-Butler University offers study abroad programs in Argentina, Australia, Chile, Costa Rica, England, Ireland, Mexico, New Zealand, Scotland, and Spain. Scholarship students interested in universities at the following locations will find the cost of living less expensive: Argentina (Mendoza), Australia (Adelaide, Canberra, Perth, Tasmania), England (Conventry, Canterbury, Norwich), Mexico (Mérida), Scotland (Stirling), New Zealand (Palmerston North), and Northern Ireland (Belfast). For more information on these programs, see a study abroad adviser in the International Programs office.

While Temple University International Programs administers the scholarship competition on behalf of IFSA-Butler, it is IFSA-Butler that credits the scholarship to the student's bill and that determines a student's eligibility for acceptance into one of their programs.

***ELIGIBILITY***

In order to qualify for a scholarship you must:

- 1) be enrolled as a full-time, matriculated student at Temple University at the time of application;
- 2) have a 3.0 cumulative grade point average;
- 3) meet the eligibility requirements for the IFSA Butler University program to which you are applying;
- 4) enroll as a full-time student on the IFSA Butler University program;
- 5) demonstrate financial need;
- 6) be a U.S. citizen or Permanent Resident.

It is not necessary for a student to have been accepted into the IFSA-Butler University program at the time of submitting the scholarship application. However, being selected by Temple for one of the IFSA-Butler scholarships does not guarantee that a student will be accepted into the study abroad program. If a student is not accepted into the IFSA-Butler program, the scholarship will not be awarded.

***APPLICATION PROCESS***

Please complete both sides of the attached scholarship application form. Be sure to sign and date the bottom of the second page.

Recipients will be asked to submit the non-Temple study abroad program evaluation upon returning from the study abroad program. The evaluations can be picked up in the International Programs office.

***APPLICATION DEADLINES***

For the fall semester, the completed scholarship application must be **RECEIVED** on or before **April 1**. For the spring semester, the completed scholarship application must be **RECEIVED** on or before **October 1**. If you prefer, you may fax the forms and your essay to International Programs, (215) 204-0729.

Please note that Temple students who apply for this scholarship may still apply for other scholarships offered through IFSA/Butler University. The general scholarship fund deadlines and program application deadlines vary by country and are listed on [www.ifsa-butler.org](http://www.ifsa-butler.org), and in the different Butler catalogs.
