## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES:

All graduate applicants must complete a Temple University graduate application. The preferred application method is the online application located at [www.temple.edu/grad/admissions/howtoapply.htm](http://www.temple.edu/grad/admissions/howtoapply.htm). A paper application is available in pdf format at the same site. The current online application is \$60 and the paper application is \$65. Check the Graduate School websites for updates or changes to the application fee.

Portfolios for the MFA, MEd, and MArch programs MUST be submitted online at [www.temple.slideroom.com](http://www.temple.slideroom.com). SlideRoom is a service that allows applicants to create and manage online portfolios for a \$10 fee. Both still images and video can be uploaded- submission details are located on SlideRoom's site. ## STANDARDIZED TESTS:

### English Language Proficiency:

Prospective students for ALL graduate study may be required to report official scores from a test of academic English (TOEFL or IELTS) if they have not earned a degree, either bachelor's or post-graduate, from a US institution. ### Academic Tests:

There is no standardized test requirement for the MFA program.

The GRE is required for the MA and PhD programs in Art History and MArch program. Candidates for the MEd program can submit either the GRE or MAT (Millers Analogies Test). Please see the Graduate Bulletin for more details [www.temple.edu/gradbulletin](http://www.temple.edu/gradbulletin).

**March 1** For receipt of all application materials for the MFA in Metals/Jewelry/CAD-CAM.
