FALL UNDERGRADUATE DEADLINES (check the Tyler and Temple websites for updates)

Feb. 1 For portfolio reviews for freshman applicants wishing to be considered for any portfolio-based BFA scholarships. Freshman BFA applicants sending CD-ROMS for review must ensure that the appropriate materials are received in the Tyler Admissions Office on or before Feb.1. If uploading a portfolio to www.temple.slideroom.com, the images must be uploaded by Feb 1. There are no extensions granted and no exceptions to this deadline.

March 1 For receipt of all application materials for BFA transfer applicants for portfolio-based scholarship consideration.

For receipt of all application materials and scholarship portfolio images for BFA freshman applicants who have passed the review by Feb.1 and wish to compete for a portfolio-based scholarship.

Priority deadline for receipt of all freshman application materials for BA, BFA, BS, Architecture programs. Applications received after March 1 will be reviewed on a rolling admission basis dependent on space availability. **Please note:** Tyler has gone to a BFA and Architecture waitlist well before the March 1 deadline, so get your applications in early!

June 1 Priority deadline for receipt of all transfer application materials for BA, BFA, BS, Architecture programs. Applications received after June 1 will be reviewed on a rolling admission basis dependent on space availability. **Please note:** Tyler has gone to a waitlist months before the deadline based on the volume of applications.

FALL GRADUATE DEADLINES (Some departments may extend the deadline; call the specific department to request an extension)

Jan. 15 For receipt of all graduate application materials for those who wish to be considered for University-wide Fellowships.

For receipt of all application materials for the MArch in Architecture, MFA in Ceramics, Fibers, Glass, Graphic & Interactive Design, Painting/Drawing, Photography, Printmaking, Sculpture.

March 1 For receipt of all application materials for the MFA in Metals/Jewelry/CAD-CAM.

April 1 For receipt of all application materials for the MEd in Art Education program.

April 15 For receipt of all application materials for the MA and PhD programs in Art History.

SPRING UNDERGRADUATE DEADLINES

Nov. 1 For receipt of all application and renewal application materials for the BA, BFA, BS programs. Please note that Tyler does not accept freshman applicants to Architecture in the Spring semester. Transfer applicants to Architecture who have taken college level architecture studio classes may apply for Spring.

SPRING GRADUATE DEADLINES

Nov.1 For receipt of all application materials for the MEd in Art Education program.

Nov. 15 For receipt of all application materials for the MA and PhD programs in Art History. There is generally no Spring admission into the MFA or March program. Please note that there are some departments that may grant an exception in an unusual situation. Please contact the individual areas for permission to apply for the Spring semester.
