Recommendation: That the Academic Affairs Committee approve the recommendation of the President, pursuant to the procedures outlined in the *Temple University Faculty Handbook* and the Collective Bargaining Agreement between Temple University – Of The Commonwealth System of Higher Education and the Temple Association of University Professionals, regarding the granting of faculty tenure, and also recommends that the Board of Trustees grant tenure to the faculty on the list on file in the Office of the Provost. <u>Recommendation:</u> That the Academic Affairs Committee, upon the recommendation made by the President, recommend to the Board of Trustees that the officers be authorized to transfer the tenure of Associate Professor Matthew Tincani from the Department of Psychological Studies in the College of Education to the Department of Teaching and Learning in the College of Education.
